

A Gentle Man

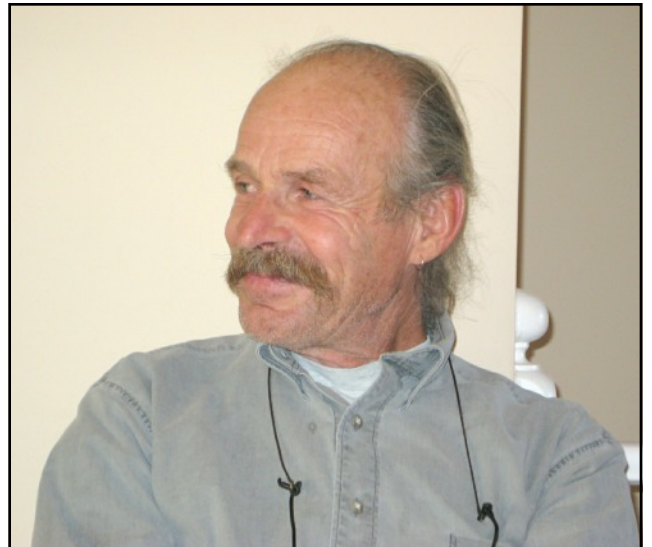
Lynn is described as thoughtful and kind,

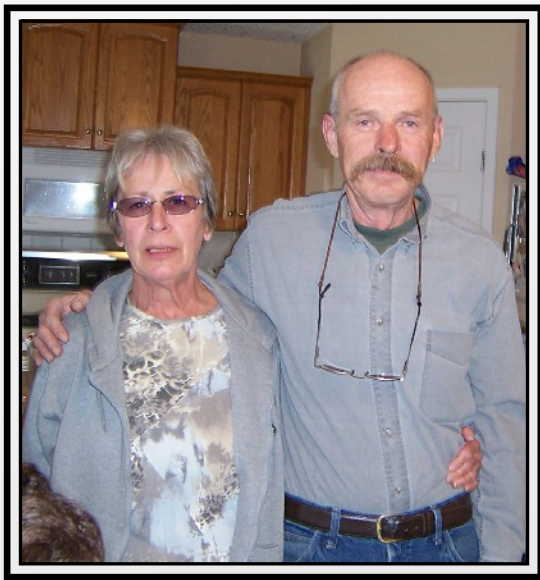
