“Surrendering Self”

In 1990, my parents, Reed and Marie Zemp, requested a 12 month mission in the United States or Canada. Mother was concerned about Grandmother and didn't want to be gone too long or too far. Soon after the papers arrived in Salt Lake City, they received a phone call from a good friend, Elder Sackley, asking if they would serve for a year and a half, and they quickly agreed. Reed was asked if they would go to Africa. Both were school teachers and Zimbabwe would only admit English instructors. Reed said he had better ask his wife. Marie responded, “we have made sacred covenants in the Temple, what else can we say, tell him yes!” With great humility and some trepidation, my parents agreed to accept the assignment.

They entered the mission field with determination and a willingness to learn their new responsibilities and adjust to a different culture. This humble act of accepting God's will over their own preferences was the beginning of an experience that was to become a highlight of their lives. They developed a deep love and respect for the Zimbabwe people. They were impressed by the humility and faith of the members with whom they worked and witnessed repeatedly the tender mercies of the Lord in blessing these faithful Saints. When we attune our lives to the Lord's will in humble submissiveness, we are less likely to be swayed by the pull of the world or the praise of peers. We have greatly ability to resist temptation and we are led to have rich, meaningful experiences that enhance our divine nature.

My parents' example of humility has not only blessed their lives and lives of those they served, but it has also influenced their children, grandchildren and great-grandchildren eternally.
